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I. Accountability in Government Act

Retention has always been a high priority for Northern New Mexico College. Student retention is a measure that is reported to our Higher Education Department and our Legislators on a quarterly basis. We use the data internally to identify and develop programs to address student success, and the college continues to explore opportunities to improve student persistence.

Retention is traditionally measured by tracking a cohort of first-time, full-time, Degree degree-seeking students and determining whether these students re-enroll the following Spring and again the following Fall Semester. Our published retention rates are the percent of First-Time, Full-Time NNMC Freshmen Who Re-enroll in the 2nd (spring) and 3rd (fall) Semesters.



As a response to the analyses, Northern has developed and implemented an integrated, campus-wide approach to first-year student retention that includes mandatory advising, and a revised new student orientation.

This retention study takes a look at Student Retention for all students enrolled at NNMC as well as Program Retention for students enrolled in individual programs. The retention rates are summarized by academic units and are sorted by the two academic schools within the College: The School of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) and The School of Liberal Arts, Business, and Education. This year also includes the Community College Branch programs in Technical Trades.

Higher education institutions (nationally) all experienced increases in both their persistence and retention rates this year (2023). <u>Source: Forbes Article College Student Persistence Bounces Back to Pre-Pandemic Level</u>. Similarly, in the academic year 2019-2020 to 2020-2021, most sectors in New Mexico experienced a decline in student retention. However, this trend was reversed in the academic year 2021-2022. The COVID-19 pandemic and the Opportunity and Lottery Scholarships likely contributed to this increase in retention from Fall 2021 to Fall 2022. Although data for Fall 2022 to Fall 2023 is not yet available, it is expected that state scholarships like the Opportunity Scholarship will continue to reduce financial difficulties for many students, allowing them to remain enrolled in colleges and universities in the state. It is important to note that during 2020 and 2021, the pandemic played a crucial role in increasing online learning opportunities in higher education in New Mexico. NNMC Retention Reports before the Fall 2019 cohort (pre-pandemic cohort) can be found on the NNMC IR website, <u>https://nnmc.edu/retention-report/</u>. This year's report focuses on the cohorts of students enrolled in Fall 2019, Fall 2020, Fall 2021, and Fall 2022. The students with declared majors are identified and categorized into the nine academic departments that are listed above. The report also includes students who have not yet declared their majors and those who have dual credit, and they are grouped accordingly.

The definitions used here are based on data elements from IPEDS. A retention rate is the percentage of students in a given cohort enrolled at NNMC in a specified term (for example, one year later). The number of students in the cohort is the denominator of the rate; the number of students enrolled one year later is the numerator of the rate calculation.

Retention Rate:

A retention rate is the percentage of students from a given cohort who graduated or were still enrolled at NNMC within a specified term (for example, one year later). The total beginning cohort is the denominator of the rate; the number of students enrolled/graduated is the numerator of the rate

Cohort Rate:

For the cohort retention rate, the total number of cohort members re-enrolled or graduated is divided by the total cohort number.

Program Rate:

For the program retention rate, the number of program cohort members re-enrolled in a specific program or graduated is divided by the total cohort number.

II.Cohort Retention: Fall 2019 to Fall 2020 to Fall 2021 to Fall 2022 to Fall 2023

The next three charts (2-4) examine the retention of all students enrolled at Northern in the Fall of 2019 and those who returned in the subsequent terms till the Fall of 2023. 


Chart 2: Fall 19 Cohort Retention by Academic Unit




Chart 3: Fall 19 Cohort Retention by Academic Unit FTAC




Chart 4: Fall 19 Cohort Retention by Academic Unit Non-FTAC

Chart 5: Fall 20 Cohort Retention by Academic Unit





Chart 6: Fall 20 Cohort Retention by Academic Unit FTAC




Chart 8: Fall 21 Cohort Retention by Academic Unit





Chart 9: Fall 21 Cohort Retention by Academic Unit FTAC




Chart 11: Fall 22 Cohort Retention by Academic Unit




Chart 12: Fall 22 Cohort Retention by Academic Unit FTAC





Chart 13: Fall 22 Cohort Retention by Academic Unit Non-FTAC



Chart 14: Fall 19 program Retention by Academic Unit









Chart 16: Fall 19 program Retention for Non-FTAC students

Chart 17: Fall 20 program Retention by Academic Unit




Chart 18: Fall 20 program Retention for FTAC students





Chart 19: Fall 20 program Retention for Non-FTAC Students





Chart 20: Fall 21 program Retention by Academic Unit





Chart 23: Fall 2022 Program Retention




Chart 24: Fall 2022 Program Retention FTAC




Chart 25: Fall 2022 Program Retention Non-FTAC

Northern College is continually working on initiatives to support and improve student retention. The college understands the importance of individualized student support and its contribution to higher retention rates. To achieve this, Northern College has committed to implementing various student retention initiatives, including the following:

- 1. Campus-wide student advisement involving professional staff and faculty to support students in their first year.
- 2. Implementation of a Corequisite Developmental Education Model in the ECHO Project with NM Higher Education Institutions.
- 3. Participation and development of a Comprehensive Retention Plan.
- 4. Creation of a Strategic Enrollment Management Plan.
- 5. Renovation and creation of a one-stop shop for Student Services.
- 6. ENLACE New Mexico will soon reestablish its presence at Northern. This year's focus will be on community engagement and workforce development

Through these efforts, Northern College is committed to continuous improvement in student satisfaction and engagement by analyzing and improving these retention initiatives.

It is essential to note that many of our students face various non-academic issues, including food insecurity, lack of transportation, and absence of internet access at home. Northern is taking steps to address these non-cognitive factors by establishing a food pantry and a clothing closet. Additionally, Northern has launched a peer tutoring initiative with course-embedded tutors in high-attrition courses. This tutoring center will complement the existing math and writing tutoring centers. Northern recently announced receiving a \$700,000 grant award from Governor Michelle Lujan Grisham's Casa Connection Grant Program. This will be used to develop affordable housing for students, faculty, and staff. The New Mexico Basic Needs Insecurity Survey, conducted by the Basic Needs Project at the University of New Mexico, reveals that 62% of student, faculty, and staff respondents from Northern reported experiencing housing insecurity. Addressing the housing needs of Northern's students, faculty, and staff is crucial for their success, and wellbeing, and to advance the educational mission of Northern New Mexico College.
